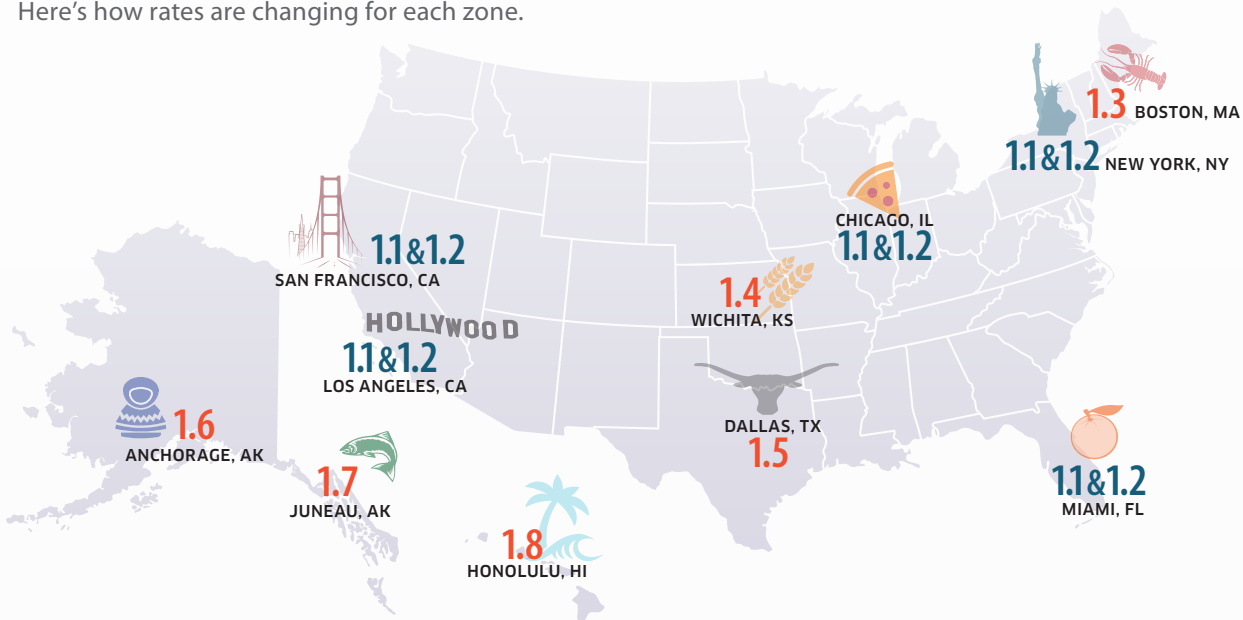


Shipping to Canada, Eh?

Find out how USPS® New Zone-Based Pricing Will Impact Your Business

On May 31, 2015, Priority Mail International® to Canada will switch to zone-based pricing, which means that shipping rates will be based on seven pricing zones rather than having one flat rate for the entire country.

The benefit? The USPS will charge shipping based on your U.S. origin ZIP code and Canadian destination ZIP code instead of having to factor expensive routes into one blended rate. Here's how rates are changing for each zone.
